BEFORE THE COMMISSION:

On March 11, 2003, a joint application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, and Three River Communications, L.L.C. (Three River) of Lynch, Nebraska, seeking approval of a statement of generally available terms (SGAT) and conditions for interconnection, unbundled network elements, ancillary services, and resale of telecommunications services. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 14, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(f) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and Three River entered into a SGAT for interconnection, unbundled network elements, ancillary services and resale of telecommunications services. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act) requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the SGAT agreement should be approved

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the wireline SGAT interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and Three River Communications, L.L.C., be, and it is hereby, approved.
