BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 3, 2004, AT&T communications of the Midwest, Inc. and TCG Omaha (collectively "AT&T") filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file the Arbitrated Interconnection Agreement ("Agreement") entered into with Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") required pursuant to the Commission's Mediation and Arbitration Policy established in Application No. C-1128, Progression Order No. 3.

The Arbitrator's decision was filed with the Commission on May 4, 2004. The Agreement based upon that decision was due to be filed with the Commission on or before June 4, 2004. AT&T has requested that the deadline be extended to June 14, 2004, to allow it an opportunity to fully examine and verify the Agreement and ensure that it is consistent with the recommendations of the Arbitrator. AT&T further alleges that such an extension will not prejudice the parties. Qwest does not oppose the motion.

Upon full consideration of the facts and circumstances, the Commission finds that the Motion to extend the deadline for filing of the Agreement should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Motion for Extension of Time shall be granted and that the parties shall file the Arbitrated Interconnection Agreement with the Commission no later than 5:00 p.m., on June 14, 2004.
