BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 5, 2004, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Agreement for Terms and Conditions for Interconnection Unbundled Network Elements, Ancillary Services, and Resale of Telecommunications Services with CAT Communications International, Inc. (CAT) of Roanoke, Virginia. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 7, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and CAT entered into a wireline interconnection agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the wireline interconnection agreement should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the wireline interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and CAT Communications International, Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed wireline interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
