BEFORE THE COMMISSION:

On May 20, 2004, an application was filed by United Telephone Company of the West, d/b/a Sprint (Sprint), Overland Park, Kansas, seeking approval of its master interconnection, collocation, and resale agreement with 1-800-Reconex, Inc., d/b/a US Tel (US Tel), Hubbard, Oregon. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 27, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Sprint and US Tel entered into a master interconnection, collocation, and resale agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the master interconnection and resale agreement should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the master interconnection, collocation, and resale agreement between United Telephone Company of the West, d/b/a Sprint, and 1-800-Reconex, Inc., d/b/a US Tel, be, and it is hereby, approved.
