O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On May 21, 2004, Qwest Corporation (Qwest), Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Commercial Line-Sharing Amendment with DIECA Communications, Inc., d/b/a Covad Communications Company (Covad), Santa Clara, California. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 3, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On April 23, 2002, pursuant to Application C-2325, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and Covad was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by adding terms, conditions and rates for Commercial Line Sharing. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed May 3, 2005, should be approved.

O R D E R



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.



