BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 16, 2004, a joint application was filed by Citizens Telecommunications Company of Nebraska, d/b/a Frontier Communications (Frontier) of Mound, Minnesota, and NE Colorado Cellular, Inc. (NE Colorado Cellular), of Fort Morgan, Colorado, seeking approval of their Interconnection and Traffic Interchange Agreement for Cellular and Other 2-Way Radio Services. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on July 20, 2004. No protest were filed; therefore this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Frontier and NE Colorado Cellular entered into an Interconnection and Traffic Interchange Agreement for Cellular and Other 2-Way Radio Services agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunication carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those

standards, the Interconnection and Traffic Interchange Agreement For Cellular and Other 2-Way Radio Services filed on July 16, 2004, should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Interconnection and Traffic Interchange Agreement For Cellular and Other 2-Way Radio Services between Citizens Telecommunications Company of Nebraska, d/b/a Frontier Communications, and NE Colorado Cellular, Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
