BEFORE THE COMMISSION:

On July 16, 2004, an application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of its agreement to adopt Qwest Corporation's Statement of Generally Accepted Terms and (SGAT) Associated Exhibits with Lightyear Network Solutions (Lightyear), Louisville, Kentucky. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 21, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and Lightyear entered into an interconnection and resale agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. The parties choose to adopt Qwest's SGAT and Associated Exhibits. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure that they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the application filed on July 16, 2004, should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Statement of Generally Available Terms and Associated Exhibits between Qwest Corporation and Lightyear Network Solutions, be, and it is hereby, approved.
