BEFORE THE COMMISSION:

On October 13, 2004, an application was filed by United Telephone Company of the West, d/b/a Sprint (Sprint) of Overland Park, Kansas, seeking approval of its Interconnection Agreement for Commercial Mobile Radio Services (CMRS) with Alltel Communications of Nebraska (Alltel) of Little Rock, Arkansas. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 18, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Sprint and Alltel entered into an interconnection agreement for CMRS arrived at through voluntary good faith negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection agreement for CMRS should be approved.


