O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On October 13, 2004, Qwest Communications (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Commercial Line-Sharing Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement with Mobius Communications Company (Mobius) of Hemingford, Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 18, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On January 8, 2002, pursuant to Application No. C-2637, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and Mobius was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by adding terms and conditions for commercial line sharing. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed October 13, 2004, should be approved.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.


