O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On October 15, 2004, Qwest Communications (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its DS0/DS1 Multiplexing Amendment to its Interconnection Agreement with Cox Nebraska Telcom, LLC (Cox) of Atlanta, Georgia previously granted in Docket No. C-1473. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 18, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On January 10, 1997, pursuant to Application No. C-1473, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest (then known as US West) and Cox (then known as Cox Nebraska Telecom) was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by adding terms and rates for DS0/DS1 Multiplexing. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed October 15, 2004, should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Communications and Cox Nebraska Telcom, LLC, be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
