O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On October 20, 2004, Qwest Communications (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its DC Power Measuring Amendment to its Interconnection Agreement with McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc., (McLeod) of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, previously granted in Application No. C-2023. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 25, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

In the current application, Qwest and McLeod seek to amend the agreement by adding terms and conditions to their existing interconnection agreement. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed October 20, 2004, should be approved.

O R D E R






