O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On December 23, 2004, Qwest Communications (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its amendment to Interconnection Agreement for Elimination of UNE-P and Implementation of Batch Hot Cut Process and Discounts with ACN Communications Services, Inc., Farmington Hills, Michigan. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 30, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On June 22, 2004, pursuant to Application C-3203, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and ACN was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks approval of its amendment to Interconnection Agreement for Elimination of UNE-P and Implementation of Batch Hot Cut Process and Discounts. An executed copy of the interim amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed December 23, 2004, should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Communications and ACN Communications Services, Inc. be, and it is hereby, approved.
