BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed January 20, 2005, OrbitCom, Inc. (Orbit) of Sioux Falls, South Dakota, seeks approval of its Reciprocal Compensation Interconnection Agreement with Verizon Wireless (Verizon) of Walnut Creek California. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 24, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Orbit and Verizon entered into an Interconnection agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection and service resale agreement should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Interconnection and Service Resale Agreement between OrbitCom, Inc. and Verizon Wireless, be, and it is hereby, approved.




