O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On February 3, 2005, Qwest Communications (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking approval of its Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement for Elimination of UNE-P and Implementation of Batch Hot Cut Process and Discounts with Budget Phone, Inc. (Budget) Shreveport, Louisiana, for the State of Nebraska, previously granted in Docket No. C-2774. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 15, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On September 11, 2002, pursuant to Application C-2774, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and Budget was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by eliminating UNE-P and Implementing Batch Hot Cut Process and Discounts. An executed copy of the interim amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed February 3, 2005 should be approved.
