O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On February 16, 2005, an application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, and Pinpoint Communications, Inc. (Pinpoint) of Cambridge, Nebraska, seeking approval of the Fifth Amendment to their interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 25, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On October 30, 2001, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and Pinpoint was approved by this Commission, pursuant to Application No. C-2605. In the current application, Qwest and McLeod seek to once again amend their agreement. Executed copies of the amendment are contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Amendment to the interconnection agreement for Elimination of UNE-P and Implementation of Batch Hot Cut Process and Discounts between Qwest Corporation and Pinpoint Communications, Inc., be, and is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
