O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On February 16, 2005, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking Expedites for Design Services Amendment to the interconnection agreement with MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC, Englewood, Colorado, previously granted in C-2257. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 25, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On April 11, 2000, pursuant to Application C-2257, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC., was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest is seeking expedites for design services amendment to the interconnection agreement. An executed copy of the interim amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed February 16, 2005, should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC, be, and it is hereby, approved.
