O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On February 24, 2005, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking to amend an interconnection agreement for Commercial Line-Sharing Amendment with Community Internet Systems, Columbus, previously granted in C-2702. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 7, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On April 23, 2002, pursuant to Application C-2702, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and Community Internet Systems was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement for Commercial Line Sharing. An executed copy of the interim amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed February 24, 2005, should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and Nebraska Community Internet Systems, be, and it is hereby, approved.
