O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On March 14, 2005, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking an amendment to an interconnection agreement for the Elimination of UNE-P and Implementation of Batch Hot Cut and Discounts with Bullseye Telecom, Inc., Oak Park, Michigan. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 23, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On May 11, 2004, pursuant to Application C-3179, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and Bullseye Telecom, Inc. was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks an amendment to an interconnection agreement to eliminate UNE-P and implement Batch Hot Cut and Discounts. An executed copy of the interim amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed March 14, 2005, should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and Bullseye Telecom, Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.
