O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On March 18, 2005, an application was filed by United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a Sprint, (Sprint) Overland Park, Kansas, and with Allo Communications LLC (Allo) Imperial, seeking approval of an interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 29, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), these entities negotiated an interconnection agreement. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the negotiated interconnection agreement should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the interconnection agreement negotiated by United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a Sprint and Allo Communications LLC, be, and it is hereby, approved.
