O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On March 25, 2005, a joint application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) Denver, Colorado, and CAT Communications International, Inc. (CAT) Roanoke, Virginia, seeking approval of Amendment 2 to their interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 30th, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On June 8, 2004, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and CAT was approved by this Commission, pursuant to Application C-3200. In the current application, Qwest and CAT seek to amend their agreement. Executed copies of the amendment are contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed should be approved.
