BEFORE THE COMMISSION:

On March 30, 2005, a joint application was filed by United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a Sprint (United) Overland Park, Kansas, and Airwave Wireless Communications, Inc. (Airwave) of Scottsbluff, seeking approval of their Master Interconnection, Collocation and Resale Agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 6, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), United and Airwave entered into a Master Interconnection, Collocation and Resale Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as, all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the Master Interconnection, Collocation and Resale Agreement filed on March 30, 2005 should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Master Interconnection, Collocation and Resale Agreement between United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a Sprint and Airwave Wireless Communications, Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.
