O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On May 3, 2005, Community Internet Systems, Inc. (CIS), Columbus, filed an application seeking approval of a Facility Connected Collocation Amendment to the interconnection agreement with Qwest Corporation (Qwest), Denver, Colorado. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 13, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On April 23, 2002, pursuant to Application C-2702, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and CIS was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by adding terms, conditions and rates for Facility Connected Collocation. An executed copy of the interim amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed May 3, 2005, should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and Community Internet Systems, Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.
