O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On May 6, 2005, a joint application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest), Denver, Colorado, and TCG Omaha (TCG), Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of Amendment No. 11 to their interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 17, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On July 18, 1996, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and Pinpoint was approved by this Commission, pursuant to Application C-1379. In the current application, Qwest and TCG seek to once again amend their agreement. Executed copies of the amendment are contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Amendment No. 11 to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and TCG Omaha be, and is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.


