O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On May 25, 2005, Qwest Corporation (Qwest), Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking expedite for design services amendment to the interconnection agreement with AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. (AT&T), Denver, Colorado, and TCG Omaha, Denver Colorado. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 27, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On July 27, 2004, pursuant to Application C-3095, the original interconnection agreement between Qwest and AT&T was approved by this Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks expedite for design services amendment to the interconnection agreement. An executed copy of the interim amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed May 25, 2005, should be approved.

O R D E R



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.


