O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On July 29, 2005, Qwest Corporation (Qwest), Denver, Colorado, filed an application seeking a triennial review order and triennial review remand order amendment to the Interconnection Agreement with XO Communications, of Salt Lake City, Utah, previously approved in Docket No. C-3035. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 2, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by modifying terms to be consistent with the Triennial Review Order and Triennial Review Remand Order issued by the FCC. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed July 29, 2005, should be approved.
