O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On July 29, 2005, an application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest), Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of a Collocation Joint Inventory Visit Amendment No. 3 to the interconnection agreement with AT&T of the Midwest, Inc. (AT&T), Denver, Colorado, previously approved in Application No. C-3095. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 4, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and AT&T entered into an interconnection agreement, which was approved by the Commission on January 22, 2004 in Application C-3095. In the current application, Qwest and AT&T seek to once again amend their agreement. Executed copies of the amendment are contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed July 29, 2005, should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and AT&T of the Midwest, Inc. be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed amendment filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
