BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 31, 2005, KMC Telecom Holdings, Inc., d/b/a KMC Telecom V Inc. (KMC V), Lawrenceville, Georgia, seeks an amendment to its interconnection agreement with ALLTEL Nebraska, Inc. (Alltel), Little Rock, Arkansas, which was previously approved in Docket C-2611. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 8, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), KMC V and Alltel filed an amendment to their interconnection agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this amendment is contained within the application.

Neither the amendment nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review amendments to interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between KMC Telecom V Inc. and ALLTEL Nebraska, Inc. be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amended executed interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
