O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On November 28, 2005, an application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest), Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of an amendment to its interconnection agreement with Trinsic Communications, Inc. (Trinsic), Tampa, Florida. The Commission previously approved a name change from Z-Tel Communications to Trinsic Communications, Inc. in Application No. C-3318. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 6, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and Trinsic f/k/a Z-Tel entered into an interconnection agreement, which was approved by the Commission on August 21, 2001, in Application C-2561. In the current application, Qwest and Trinsic seek to once again amend their agreement. Executed copies of the amendment are contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as

all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed November 28, 2005, should be approved.
