O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By application filed February 3, 2006, Qwest Corporation (Qwest), Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of a Line Splitting Amendment to its interconnection agreement with Metropolitan Telecommunications of Nebraska, Inc. (Metropolitan). Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 10, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

The original interconnection agreement between Qwest and Metropolitan was docketed by the Commission in Application No. C-3538. In the present application, Qwest and Metropolitan seek to amend their agreement. Executed copies of the amendment are contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed should be approved.

O R D E R


