BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed May 16, 2006, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of an interconnection agreement with 360networks (USA), Inc., (360networks) of Seattle, Washington. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 24, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and 360networks entered into an interconnection agreement using Qwest's Statement of Generally Available Terms (SGAT). An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(f) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted pursuant to SGAT to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection agreement should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the interconnection agreement between Qwest Communications, Denver, Colorado, and 360networks (USA), Inc., Seattle, Washington, be, and it is hereby, approved.
