BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 6, 2006, an application was filed by Eastern Nebraska Telephone Company, Blair, Nebraska, seeking approval of its Wireless Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement with NPCR, Inc., Overland Park, Kansas. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 12, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Eastern Nebraska Telephone Company and NPCR, Inc. entered into an interconnection agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection and service resale agreement should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Wireless Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement between Eastern Nebraska Telephone Company and NPCR Inc. be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
