BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed October 17, 2006, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, and TransNational Communications International, Inc. (TransNational), of Boston, Massachusetts, seek approval to adopt by Section 252(i) a wireline interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 23, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and TransNational seek to adopt the wireline interconnection agreement approved by the Commission between Qwest and 360networks (USA), Inc. in Application No. C-3601 on July 5, 2006. Qwest and 360networks (USA), Inc. entered into a voluntary agreement using Qwest's Statement of Generally Available Terms (SGAT).

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection agreement should be approved.


