BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed October 20, 2006, Cambridge Telephone Company, (Cambridge) of Cambridge, seeks approval of an Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement with Pinpoint Wireless, Inc., (Pinpoint) of Cambridge. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 25, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Cambridge and Pinpoint entered into an Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection agreement should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Interexchange and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement between Cambridge Telephone Company and Pinpoint Wireless, Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.
