O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On February 11, 2008, an application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest), of Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of an Omaha Forbearance Order ("OFO") Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement with BullsEye Telecom, Inc. (BullsEye), of Oak Park, Michigan, which was previously approved by the Commission in Docket C-3179. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 22, 2008. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On May 11, 2004, in Docket C-3179, the original Interconnection Agreement between Qwest and BullsEye was approved by the Commission. In the current application, Qwest seeks to amend the agreement by adding an Omaha Forbearance Order Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement. An executed copy of the amendment is contained within the application.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed February 11, 2008, should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation and BullsEye Telecom, Inc., be, and it is hereby, approved.
