BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 9, 2008, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of a CLEC Consolidation Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement with LH Telecom, Inc., (LH Telecom) Des Moines, Iowa, previously granted in Docket C-3220. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 11, 2008. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and LH Telecom (parties) entered into a Interconnection Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations and previously granted in Docket C-3220. The parties now wish to amend the agreement further through a CLEC Consolidation Amendment. An executed copy of this amendment is contained within the application.

Neither the amendment nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the CLEC Consolidation Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement should be approved.

O R D E R


