BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed September 9, 2008, Citizens Telecommunications Company of Nebraska d/b/a Frontier Communications of Nebraska (Frontier), Rochester, New York, is seeking approval of a local and EAS Service Agreement with Charter Fiberlink-Nebraska, LLC (Charter), St. Louis, Missouri. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 10, 2008. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Frontier and Charter entered into a local and EAS Service agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review service agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the service agreement should be approved.
