BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed September 15, 2008, Qwest Corporation (Qwest), Denver, Colorado, seeks approval of an Originated Toll Free Service Jointly Provided Switched Access (JPSA) Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement with MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC (CLEC), Ashburn, Virginia. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 17, 2008. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and CLEC entered into an Interconnection Agreement arrived at through voluntary negotiations and previously granted in Docket C-3703. An executed copy of this agreement is contained within the application.

Neither the agreement nor any portion thereof discriminates against any telecommunications carrier. Furthermore, the implementation of the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review interconnection agreements adopted by negotiation or arbitration to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the interconnection agreement should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Originated Toll Free Service Jointly Provided Switched Access Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC, be, and it is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executed interconnection agreement filed herein be, and it is hereby, made the official copy on file with the Nebraska Public Service Commission.
