On October 8, 1996, pursuant to Application No. C-1362, Viatel Services, Inc., formally known as Destia and Econophone, Inc. of New York City, New York, was granted authority by this Commission to provide resold telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.


By letter dated November 20, 2001, Viatel has requested that its certificate be canceled. On May 2, 2001, Viatel filed for Chapter 11 Bankruptcy and has discontinued telecommunications service throughout the United States. Viatel has no customers in the state of Nebraska.
