BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 11, 2002, an application was filed by LCR Telecommunications, L.L.C. (LCR) of Grosse Pointe Woods, Michigan, seeking authority to operate as a resale common carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 12, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

LCR is a Michigan Corporation with its headquarters in Grosse Point Woods, Michigan. LCR has been authorized by the Secretary of State to operate in Nebraska as a foreign corporation. No officer, director or shareholder having five percent or more of the applicant's voting securities has been involved in a formal complaint or other investigatory or enforcement proceeding.

Applicant is an interexchange resale carrier, which intends to provide switched and dedicated to switched interexchange telecommunications services. Applicant will neither provide alternative operator services nor will own or lease facilities in the state of Nebraska. Applicant proposes to offer "1+" long distance telecommunications services suitable for voice and limited data applications along with prepaid calling cards, postpaid calling cards, toll-free service and directory assistance.

Interexchange reseller applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-604 and 86-805 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds LCR has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service and possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2703 be, and it is hereby, granted and LCR Telecommunications, L.L.C., is authorized to operate as a resale common carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall file, in accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting of: (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission; (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders; and (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission. If these are not available, applicant shall submit a balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation, as well as the investment made in telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues and expenses, and taxes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent applicable, the applicant shall comply with all laws pertaining to, and all rules and regulations promulgated under, the Telecommunications Relay System Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-1302 to 86-1307) and the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-1402 to 86-1410).



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file a current tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.
