BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 30, 2002, Trilogy Telemanagement, L.L.C. (Trilogy) of Omaha, Nebraska, seeks to discontinue its common carrier telecommunications operations authority granted in Application No. C-1382 and withdraw associated tariffs. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 2, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Trilogy was authorized by this Commission to operate as a resale carrier of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska on October 22, 1996, pursuant to Application No. C-1382.

By letter dated April 30, 2002, Trilogy gave notice that it currently wishes to discontinue service in Nebraska and therefore requests that its certificate to provide such service be withdrawn. Network has no pending departmental, formal or informal complaints with the Commission.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Trilogy may withdraw the certificate previously issued to it in Application No. C-1382.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2730 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority granted to Trilogy Telemanagement, L.L.C. and its initial tariff are withdrawn.


