BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed September 3, 2002, Logix Communications Corporation (Logix) of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, seeks authority to withdraw its certificate of authority granted in Application No. C-1979 and associated tariff. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 5, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Logix was authorized by this Commission to operate as a resale carrier of telecommunications services in Nebraska on March 2, 1999, pursuant to Application No. C-1979.

By letter dated August 29, 2002, Logix gave notice that it currently wishes to discontinue service in Nebraska and therefore, requests that its certificate to provide such service be withdrawn. Logix, at the time of their filing, had 10 customers in the state of Nebraska. Logix entered into an agreement with Alternatel to provide long distance service to these customers, but also informed them of their ability to switch to a different carrier. Logix has no pending departmental, formal or informal complaints with the Commission.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Logix may withdraw the certificate previously issued to it in Application No. C-1979.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2805 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority granted to Logix Communications Corporation and its initial tariff are withdrawn.
