BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed January 3, 2003, Lockheed Martin Global Telecommunications Service, Inc. (Lockheed) of Orlando, Florida, seeks authority to surrender its certificate of authority for resold interexchange telecommunications services granted in Application No. C-2601. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 6, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Lockheed was authorized by this Commission to operate as a reseller of interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska on November 6, 2001, pursuant to Application No. C-2601.

By letter dated December 29, 2002, Lockheed gave notice that it currently wishes to discontinue service in Nebraska and therefore requests that its certificate to provide such service be withdrawn. Lockheed has never conducted business in the state and does not have any revenues or customers in Nebraska. Lockheed has no pending departmental, formal or informal complaints with the Commission.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Lockheed may withdraw the certificate previously issued to it in Application No. C-2601.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2859 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority granted to Lockheed Martin Global Telecommunications Services, Inc. and its initial tariff are withdrawn.
