By application filed August 21, 2003, T-NETIX Internet Services, Inc. (T-NETIX) of Dallas, Texas, seeking authority to withdraw its certificate of authority granted in Application No. C-2391. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 2, 2003. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

T-NETIX was authorized by this Commission to operate as a reseller of telecommunications services in Nebraska on November 28, 2000, pursuant to Application No. C-2391.

By letter dated August 20, 2003, T-NETIX gave notice that it currently wishes to discontinue service in Nebraska and therefore requests that its certificate to provide such service be withdrawn. T-NETIX has never conducted business in the state and does not have any revenues or customers in Nebraska. T-NETIX has no pending departmental, formal or informal complaints with the Commission.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that T-NETIX may withdraw the certificate previously issued to it in Application No. C-2391.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3009 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority granted to T-NETIX Internet Services, Inc., and its initial tariff are withdrawn.
