BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 12, 2004, an application was filed by Zoom-I-Net Communications, Inc. (Applicant) of Central Square, New York, seeking authority to operate as a resale interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 16, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a closely held corporation, organized under the laws of the state of Nevada with its headquarters in Central Square, New York. Applicant has been authorized by the Secretary of State to operate in Nebraska as a foreign corporation.

Applicant is a resale-based interexchange carrier providing intrastate long distance message toll telecommunications services to customers for their direct transmission and reception of voice communication. These long distance services are provided over the networks of its facilities-based underlying carrier. Applicant is solely dependent on the technical capabilities of its underlying carrier. Applicant proposes to offer resold "1+" equal access long distance telecommunications services, toll-free, and calling card long distance telecommunications services suitable for voice in the state of Nebraska.

Interexchange reseller applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-128 and 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds Applicant has provided all the information required, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service. The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3158 be, and it is hereby, granted and Zoom-I-Net Communications, Inc., is authorized to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant shall file, in accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting of: (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission; (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders; and (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission. If these are not available, Applicant shall submit a balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation, as well as the investment made in telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues and expenses, and taxes, together with the appropriate filing fee.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent applicable, the Applicant shall comply with all laws pertaining to, and all rules and regulations promulgated under, the Telecommunications Relay System Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-301 to 86-315) and the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-316 to 86-329).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant file its current tariff and pay the appropriate filing fee prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as a common carrier.
