BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed July 20, 2004, United Communications Hub, Inc. of Rancho Cucamonga, California, (United) seeks to withdraw its certificate of authority to operate as a resale common carrier of telecommunications service within the State of Nebraska, previously granted by the Commission in Application No. C-2209. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 7, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On February 29, 2000, United was granted a certificate to operate as a resale common carrier of telecommunications service within the State of Nebraska, pursuant to Application No. C-2209.

By letter received on July 20, 2004, United requested the withdrawal of its certificate of authority. United no longer has customers in Nebraska and does not intend to resell its telecommunications services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that United's certificate of authority previously granted in Application No. C-2209 should be withdrawn.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3242 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of authority previously granted to United Communications Hub, Inc., is withdrawn.
