BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 20, 1999, in Application No. C-2008, Maxxis Communications, Inc. (Maxxis or Applicant), Tucker Georgia, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Nebraska. By letter dated January 4, 2005, applicant requests that it be permitted to withdraw its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and cancel its tariff. Notice of this request was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 10, 2005.

In its letter to the Commission, Applicant states that it ceased doing business in January of 2004. Upon consideration of the request made by Applicant, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that it should be permitted to cancel its certificate and withdraw its tariff.
