BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 9, 2006, an application was filed by 800 Response Information Services, LLC ("800 Response") of Burlington, Vermont, seeking authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 16, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of modified procedure.

O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

800 Response is a limited liability company, organized under the laws of the state of Vermont. 800 Response has been authorized by the Secretary of State to operate in Nebraska as a foreign corporation.

Applicant is a non-facilities based interexchange resale carrier providing switched interexchange telecommunications services to businesses. Applicant proposes to offer these services throughout the state of Nebraska. All network services are supplied by "MCI". From time to time, Applicant may offer other services provided by other registered interexchange carriers. No officer, director or shareholder having five percent or more of the applicant's voting securities has been involved in a formal complaint or other investigatory or enforcement proceeding.

Interexchange applications are subject to Commission jurisdiction under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-129 and Title 291 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Rule 003.12. From examination of the application filed herein, the Commission finds DCT has provided all the information required by the Commission, possesses adequate financial resources to provide the proposed service, and possesses adequate technical competency to provide the proposed service. A grant of the application would serve the public interest. Accordingly, the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3594 be, and it is hereby, granted and 800 Response Information Services, LLC, is authorized to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall file, in accordance with the applicable statutes on or before April 30th of each year, an annual report with this Commission consisting of: (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission; (b) a copy of any annual report to stockholders; and (c) a copy of the latest Form 10-K filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission. If these are not available, applicant shall submit a balance sheet and income statement for the previous year of operation, as well as the investment made in telephone plant and equipment located within the state, accumulated depreciation thereon, operating revenues and expenses, and taxes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, to the extent applicable, the applicant shall comply with all laws pertaining to, and all rules and regulations promulgated under, the Telecommunications Relay System Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-301 to 86-315) and the Nebraska Telecommunications Universal Service Fund Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 86-316 to 86-329).


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file its current tariff prior to offering service pursuant to the certificate granted in this order.




