O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By application filed February 15, 2008, TransWorld Network Corp. (TransWorld or applicant) of Tampa, Florida, seeks to discontinue interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application appeared in The Daily Record on February 20, 2008. No protests or petitions of formal intervention were filed; therefore this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Docket C-3270, TransWorld was granted authority to operate as an interexchange carrier of telecommunications services in Nebraska. As of December 31, 2007, TransWorld ceased doing business in the State of Nebraska. TransWorld has no customers in Nebraska and the proposed discontinuance of service will not affect the provision of long distance service in any of those geographic areas.

Upon review of the application and circumstances presented, the Commission is of the opinion that TransWorld's request should be honored and its certificate should be cancelled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3913 be, and it is hereby, granted and the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Docket C-3270 is cancelled.




