On April 16, 2009, an application was filed by Bell Atlantic Communications, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Long Distance ("Bell Atlantic") of Arlington, Virginia, seeking a name change to Verizon Long Distance LLC. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 8, 2009. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Bell Atlantic is a corporation with its principal offices located at 1320 N. Courthouse Rd., 6th Floor, Arlington, Virginia 22201. Bell Atlantic operates pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission September 29, 1999, under Docket C-2103 and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

In the present application, Bell Atlantic requests that the Commission enter an order approving the adoption by Bell Atlantic of the name "Verizon Long Distance LLC". Bell Atlantic has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. The adoption of the new name will have no effect on the rates, terms or conditions of Bell Atlantic's provision of telecommunications services to its customers. Based on all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4160 be, and it is hereby, granted and the request of Bell Atlantic Communications, Inc. to change its name to Verizon Long Distance LLC is approved.
