No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant received authority to provide high-speed data transmission and other telecommunications services from this Commission on June 22, 1999, pursuant to Application No. C-1840. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against the applicant.

Applicant requests authority to change its name in Nebraska to @link Networks, Inc. The proposed name change will not noticeably impact customers in Nebraska and will not affect the company's management, technical abilities, or financial position. Applicant has obtained authority from the Secretary of State to change its name to @link Networks, Inc.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2135 be, and it is hereby, granted and Dakota Services Ltd. is authorized to change its name to @link Networks, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within thirty days from the date of this order.



